

Norwescon Rules for Minors

A minor as defined by the State of Washington is any child* under the age of 18. A parent, legal guardian, or an individual designated by the parent or legal guardian, must be on-site when the minor is on-site.

Minors must have a permission slip on file with Registration (See Section Below) signed by a parent or legal guardian. In the event that the parent or legal guardian will not be on-site during the convention, the parent or guardian must designate a person who will be on-site and is to be responsible for the minor. This person must be A MEMBER OF THE CONVENTION.

*In the event that a 16 or 17 year old qualifies as an emancipated minor under RCW 13.64. He/she does not have to have a permission form on file but he/she is required to provide state identification that notates his/her status upon registration.
